

If traveling north on Hwy 45:

1. Approximately 18 miles north of Tupelo, you will come to a traffic light (on four lane) at Baldwyn, MS. There will be a McDonalds on your right and a Sonic Drive-In on your left. Turn left at this light onto County Road 6100 (Ripley Road).
2. Continue on County Road 6100 for four miles until your reach Hwy 30. Turn left onto Hwy 30 and then immediately take the first right onto County Road 165 (Dry Creek Road).
3. Continue on County Road 165 for approximately 2.3 miles. At the bottom of a long hill, you'll see County Road 227 on your left. The first house on the right is the Bullock Camp.
4. You are now on the southeast corner of DCHA.

If traveling south on Hwy 45:

1. Approximately 8 miles south of Booneville, MS, you will come to an overpass displaying a Hwy 30 exit. Take the west bound exit toward New Albany.
2. Continue on Hwy 30 West for approximately 6 miles and you will see green Dry Creek sign. Turn right onto County Road 165.
3. Continue on County Road 165 for approximately 2.3 miles. At the bottom of a long hill, you'll see County Road 227 on your left. The first house on the right is the Bullock Camp.
4. You are now on the southeast corner of DCHA.

If traveling east on Hwy 78 (I22) from Memphis:

1. Upon arriving at New Albany on Hwy 78 (I22), continue to the Hwy 15 exit. This should be the fourth exit after entering the New Albany city limits. There will be a Pilot Truck Center at the end of the correct exit. Turn left onto Hwy 15.
2. Continue on Hwy 15 north for approximately 2 miles until your reach the intersection of Hwy 30. Turn right onto Hwy 30 East. You should see Stokes Grocery while at this intersection.
3. Travel approximately 18 miles on Hwy 30 East until you see a green Dry Creek sign. Turn left onto County Road 165.
4. Continue on County Road 165 for approximately 2.3 miles. At the bottom of a long hill, you'll see County Road 227 on your left. The first house on the right is the Bullock Camp.
5. You are now on the southeast corner of DCHA.
